

CBHS Hon Astronomy Group Project #2 Manned Space Mission

Groups consist of three students, all from the same class. Each group will choose one manned space mission, of any nationality, and research it in order to prepare a five-minute presentation – with accompanying poster. The presentation should be interesting and concise. The poster should be informative, easy to read, and lovely. The presentation and poster should cover, *but need not be limited to*, the following topics:

- Dates and cost of mission
- Country or countries involved
- Purpose of mission
- Cool or unique details/facts
- Important science/astronomy investigated
- Lasting impact/importance of mission

Groups can choose any mission on a first-come, first-served basis. Email your choice to your teacher and wait for either a confirmation, or notice to choose another. Once your group has received the go ahead, begin your research. Do NOT simply plagiarize/print something from the Internet to paste to your poster. The presentation should NOT be in electronic form (NO PowerPoints, etc!) Your grades will be based on how informative, detailed, interesting and well done your poster and presentation are. The exact rubric is below. This project will have two separate grades for the poster and presentation.
